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INTRODUCTION

Founded in 1904, the *Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA)* has a mandate to govern the practice of motor sport worldwide by the authorities of 144 nations. Through the International Karting Commission (CIK-FIA), it awards the only official titles of FIA Karting World and European Champion at the end of the most prestigious Competitions, which are organised in collaboration with its Promoter RGMMC Group and the National Sporting Authorities (ASN) concerned.

In addition to motor sport, the FIA is also concerned with automobile mobility and tourism, with safety as a priority.

The purpose of this dossier is to present the Karting discipline as well as the various FIA Karting Championships, Cups and Trophies for the 2020 season.





KARTING

Invented by the Americans in the 1950s, Karting quickly became a great success in Europe and today is a fully-fledged motorsport discipline.

Karting is a great school of life for young people and the best way to learn about driving and racing. The best route for the future car Champions, Karting is also practiced by enthusiasts who devote all their energy to it. The FIA Karting Championships are open to drivers from the age of 12, with no upper age limit.

Although the kart is basically a machine of simple design, the high standard of competition makes it a very high level sport where ultra-competent professional teams compete against each other.

The spectacle provided by Karting events has an intensity rarely seen in motor sport. The closeness of the track, a succession of races throughout the weekend, constant suspense and the beauty of the struggle for victory make it an exciting discipline to experience for both specialists and the general public.

In addition, karting is particularly suitable for live TV viewing and sharing on social networks.

The FIA Karting Academy Trophy brings together the best prospects between the ages of 12 and 14 from around 40 countries around the world to compete on a one-make basis.

CATEGORY - OK -

The OK category, accessible from the age of 14, represents the pinnacle of competition for direct-drive karts, which in the past has been called Formula A, ICA and KF. This is where we find the greatest champions in the history of karting, as well as the best young hopefuls before they move to single-seaters. The confrontation is intense between experienced Drivers and young rookies.

From 14 years old / CIK-FIA homologated chassis / rear only hydraulic brakes.

Minimum weight: 145 kg with Driver on board

Tyres : LeCont

125 cc 2-stroke with balance shaft / water-cooled / maximum revs 16000 rpm, simplified exhaust valve / one-design exhaust / 24mm butterfly carburettor in diameter. No gear shifting / no clutch / no starter / no battery.

- OK-JUNIOR - CATEGORY

The OK-Junior category is aimed at young talents who are learning their driving profession. The standard is extremely high and the competition is fierce between the 12 to 14 year old hopefuls who often race with big teams. The Junior class has long produced great motorsport champions.

Available from 12 to 14 years / CIK-FIA homologated chassis / hydraulic brakes working on the rear wheels only.

125 cc 2-stroke with balance shaft / water-cooled / maximum revs 14000 rpm / without exhaust valve / one-design exhaust / butterfly carburettor 20 mm in diameter.

No gearbox / no clutch / no starter / no battery.

Minimum weight : 140 kg with driver on board.

Tyres: LeCont for the European Championship and MG Tyres for the World Championship

In addition to its powerful gearbox motor, the KZ category is characterised by greater freedom in the chassis allowing development of the equipment. This is the domain of factory teams and professional Drivers including the greatest specialists of Karting.

Free chassis / Hydraulic brakes on all four wheels.

Engine: 125cc two-stroke with gearbox (6 speed) /
Liquid cooling / 30mm float bowl carburettor

Power: close to 50 hp

Tyres: Vega

Minimum weight (Driver on board) : 170 kg

- KZ2 - CATEGORY

The KZ2 category is characterised by its powerful engine with a gearbox. Very high performance at a relatively affordable cost attracts talented amateurs in this European Competition.

Chassis homologated internationally by the CIK-FIA / Hydraulic brakes working on all four wheels.

Power: close to 50 hp

Tyres: Vega

Engine: 125cc two-stroke with gearbox (6 speed) / Liquid cooling / 30mm float bowl carburettor

Minimum weight (Driver on board) : 175 kg



THE FIA KARTING ACADEMY TROPHY, A GLOBAL PROGRAMME FOR THE DETECTION OF YOUNG TALENTS

The FIA Karting Academy Trophy is a formula, unique in the world, aimed at training and detecting young talents between the ages of 12 and 14, pitting some 50 Drivers representing more than 40 countries and five continents.

They are tested on identical OK-Junior equipment, made available by the CIK-FIA thanks to the participation of the OTK Kart Group (chassis and engines) and tyre manufacturer Vega. The karts, strictly identical, are drawn before each round. National federations are very much involved in this commitment.

SUPERKART

Originating in Great Britain in the 70s, the Superkart has a special place in Karting Competition with specific regulations.

The power of the two-stroke 250cc twin-cylinder engines is around 100 hp for a minimum weight of 218 kg, including Driver. The extraordinary performance of these machines, capable of reaching speeds of up

to 250 km / h, is usually reserved for motor racing. The spirit of the competitors and the teams is still animated by the passion of the early days of karting. The average age is significantly higher than in the other categories of Karting. Its popularity is concentrated in the countries of the north rather than the centre of Europe.

The FIA Karting European Championship - Superkart will be held on 23rd and 25th October 2020 on the Bugatti circuit in Le Mans (FRA).
